

## How to Add Internet Explorer Browser Shortcut to Windows 10



Can you find the Big Blue "E" (in yellow halo) in Windows 10?

This icon shortcut in Windows 7 and 8.1 points to Internet Explorer. Your new installation of Windows 10 may not have an icon for Internet Explorer on the Desktop or Taskbar.

A. Follow these instructions to recover your Big Blue "E" icon:

1. Type "Internet Explorer" (without the quotes) into the Search box.
2. Right click on "Internet Explorer" in the search window.
3. Left click on "Pin to Taskbar".
4. Stop here.

B. If the above instructions don't find Internet Explorer, try the following:

1. Type "iexplore.exe" (without the quotes) into the Search box.
2. Right click on "Internet Explorer" in the search window.
3. Left click on "Pin to Taskbar".
4. Stop here.

C. If you had to use Section "B" above and didn't see the ".exe" file extension, make sure you go to the following link.
